
PDP to flag off campaign this week

Some of the lapses of parents observed by the body include delaying pupils to go late to school, improper dressing of pupils to school as well as neglect of open day visit.

Others are allowing wards to roam about the streets with their school uniforms on and fail to give them breakfast before leaving for school.

The body also listed improper care for pupils' educational needs as one of the factors militating against their success. It stated that the gradual falling away from norms and principles guiding the pupils' educational background could their end," he said.


